- 1 - Stock: Multi-position collapsible stock, adaptable for any tactical situation.
- 2 - Rear Sight: Adjusts for windage, featuring standard aperture and ghost ring.
- 3 - Mounting Rails (front & rear) readily accept optional sighting equipment.
- 4 - Non-reciprocating Charging Handle
- 5 - Front Sight: Adjusts for elevation.
- 6 - Barrel Locking Nut [with integrated counter-recoil buffer]: Permits easy removal of barrel for simple maintenance.
- 7 - Captive [tapered] Takedown Pin: Permits easy fieldstripping.
- 8 - Stabilizing Bracket: Supports buttstock in folded position and aids firing in pistol mode.
- 9 - Protected Ambidextrous Magazine Release
- 10 - 32-Round Magazine (shown): Shorter and longer magazines optional.
- 11 - Compact Front Grip: Grip extension optional.
