#### THE FINEST MATERIALS AND CONSTRUCTION: BUILT FOR DURABILITY

The quality of any product is dependent not only upon good craftsmanship, but also upon the tools and materials used in its construction.

To insure the close tolerances and consistency critical to the manufacture of the UZI SUB-MACHINEGUN DESIGN, computer-operated milling machines and lathes are used.

Only the best steel-which meets military

specifications—along with proper heat treating techniques has been used in both the stamped and fully machined parts. Even the barrel has been hardchrome lined; a small detail, but an important one for increased durability.

When assembly and finishing are completed, every UZI SUB-MACHINEGUN DESIGN is fully tested for smooth functioning and reliable operation.

#### LAWFUL OWNERSHIP UNDER FEDERAL REGULATION

The National Firearms Act of 1934 has provided for the lawful ownership of machineguns for over half a century.

Under these federal regulations, ownership of the UZI SUB-MACHINEGUN DESIGN can be both easy and uncomplicated. The purchaser need only be 21 years of age, a U.S. citizen, and have a clean record with no criminal charges.

Although federal regulations require that the proper paperwork be submitted for transfer approval, all forms necessary are supplied already completed except for the required signatures. All you must do is simply obtain these signatures, provide passport photos and fingerprints.
